

Eileen Enny Leach, MPH, RN is currently the Chief of Staff for Urban Health Plan, Inc. She has over 20 years of clinical and administrative management experience and over 20 years of pharmaceutical industry management.

Eileen began her clinical career as a registered nurse at the Columbia-Presbyterian Medical Center in New York and has been associated with Columbia University since 1972 including having served as the Executive Director of the Clinical Trials Office for both the University and Hospital; the Departmental Administrator for the Dermatology Department at the College of Physicians and Surgeons; and Director in the Dermatology Faculty Practice and a Coordinator of Dermatology Clinical Research.
